

MAINE YMCA SWIM LEAGUE
STATE MEET 2012

TO: ALL FAMILIES OF MAINE YMCA SWIMMERS

1. The Y State Meet this year will be March 3 & 4, 2012 at the Wallace Pool at the University of Maine at Orono. There are no other events occurring this year at the University of Maine, however, please obey all parking signs or you may be ticketed.
2. After you walk in the front door of the Gym, take the right hand corridor to get to the Locker Rooms. If you enter on the Field House side (“Under the M”), stay to the right and walk all the way to the east end of the building.
3. After swimmers have changed, they should LOCK their clothes in lockers (if available) or take duffel bags on the deck and place them under the bleachers. **PLEASE DO NOT TAKE DUFFEL BAGS INTO THE SPECTATOR GALLERY.**
4. The Warm-Up schedule is as follows (Events start 1 hour after Warm-Up begins):

5. Admission for spectators is \$3.00 for Adults and \$1.00 for students **FOR EACH SESSION.** Children under 4 are free. Programs are \$1.00 for each Session.
6. **Please don't show up too early. The spectator gallery will open at 7 am on Saturday & Sunday.** We will not let people in for the later Sessions until we have emptied the Gallery from the earlier ones. At the end of each Session those spectators who have paid for the next Session will be asked to exit temporarily to clear the Gallery. Those spectators will be allowed to re-enter before the next session of spectators are permitted to enter. Those who haven't will be asked to leave promptly so we can let in the next group.
7. There is a limited spectator space at the pool. Capacity for the spectator area is 410. Once we reach that number we are forced to limit access. There will be an area for closed circuit TV to view the meet. To help make it possible for all of our parents and families to get in:
 - **Please do not take swimmers' duffels into the Spectator Gallery.**
 - **Please do not take up a seat with family duffels, ice chests, etc.** (We will insist that seats be cleared off to be available for seating.)
 - No swimmer will be allowed into the Spectator Gallery unless they pay. (Swimmers should arrange to meet their parents in one of the lobbies.)
